



From I-26 - Take I-26 from Charleston or Spartanburg. Follow the I-126 Spur into Columbia (it becomes Elmwood Avenue). Turn South (right) on Bull Street. Stay on Bull Street for seven blocks. The church campus is on the right beginning at Washington Street. See "Parking" for parking options on Sunday. From I-20 - Take the SC 277 exit (Exit 73) toward Columbia (it becomes Bull Street). After passing Elmwood Avenue, follow Bull Street for seven blocks. The church campus is on the right beginning at Washington Street. See "Parking" for parking options on Sunday. From US 1 or US 378 (76) - US 1 and US 378 coming from the West converge just before crossing the Gervais Street Bridge. After crossing the bridge, follow Gervais Street several blocks, turning North (left) on Marion Street. Go one block, and you will see the Church on the right at the corner of Marion and Lady Street. See "Parking" for parking options on Sunday. From US 378 (76) Sumter - US 378 from the East
